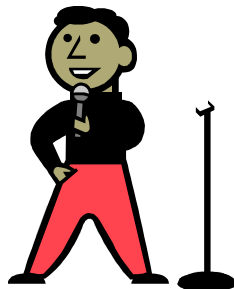

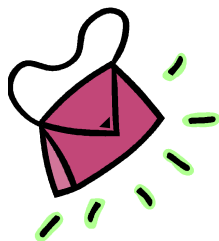

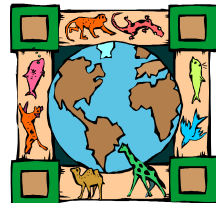

Registration:

(Please note: a \$25.00 fee will be charged for returned checks.)
- Return your completed registration form with the attached payment to your school office, to the Enrichment Office, 38 Crest Road West, Rolling Hills, CA 90274 or fax it to (310) 265-5967.

Program Policies

- **A completed registration form must be received in the Enrichment Office by 3:00 p.m. the day before the first class meeting.**
- Students may not attend class until all fees are paid. This includes any Kids' Corner or district related outstanding fees.
- **No confirmation will be sent home.**
- There will be **NO REFUNDS** after enrolling .
- There are no make-up classes and no refunds for absences.
- There are no student substitutions.
- Classes will be canceled if they do not meet minimum enrollment. If a class is cancelled, students will receive a full refund.
- Occasionally, classes must be canceled due to inclement weather. Please be available by phone on rainy days in case a class must be canceled.
- Once enrolled in the current session, you can add an additional class by calling the Enrichment Office.
- Please dress your child in appropriate clothing. Some projects are messy and clothes may be stained.

Class Attendance/Absences:

Students will meet the Enrichment Instructor and Kids' Corner Representative at the class location indicated in the brochure. If a child is not in class, the Kids' Corner Representative will find the child. For students safety, we will determine the whereabouts of every child on our class list. If your child will not attend class, please call the Enrichment Office at (310) 541-7626 (ext. 704). Failure to call uses valuable staff time in needless searching and unnecessary phone calls.

STUDENTS MUST BE PICKED UP ON TIME!!

Instructors will stay with students for ten minutes after class dismissal time. If a student is not picked up after ten minutes, he/she will be taken to the Kids' Corner room. **PARENTS WILL BE CHARGED \$1.00 PER MINUTE WHILE YOUR CHILD IS IN KIDS' CORNER DUE TO LATE PICK-UP. If your child is picked up late more than once, he/she will be dismissed from the Enrichment Program and a refund will not be issued.**

Student Behavior:

As part of the PVPUSD the Enrichment Program complies by the Safe Schools Policy. Students are expected to behave responsibly with respect for others and their school. Students who are disruptive in class will be given one warning and parents will be notified. A second offense will result in removal from the class. Students removed from the class for disciplinary reasons will forfeit class fees and parents will be notified.
